Robert G. "Bob" Becotte, 87, a resident of Salisbury, MA, formerly of Methuen, MA, passed away on Saturday, March 21, 2015 at the Lahey Hospital and Medical Center in Burlington, MA surrounded by his family. Born in Lawrence, Bob was a graduate of both St. Patrick's Grammar School and Lawrence High School. He then went on to graduate from Merrimack College with a Degree in Business. Bob had worked for the Travelers Insurance Company for 30 years and then went on to work for the McCarthy Insurance Agency for some 20 years. A United States Navy Veteran, Bob had served during World War II. He had been an attendant of St. Monica's Church in Methuen where he was an active member of the Parish Council as well as served as a Eucharistic Minister and a Lector. Bob had served as a Registrar for the Town of Salisbury, MA and was very involved at the Mary Immaculate Nursing Home in Lawrence. He had been a longtime member and past president of the Methuen-Salem Rotary Club. Bob enjoyed playing golf and was always very involved in his grandchildren's sporting and school events.
