Timothy J. Buckley, Sr. 90, a resident of Salisbury Beach died at the Beth Israel Deaconess in Boston on August 22, 2011. He was born on April 4, 1921 in Lawrence, MA. to John J. and Julia (Cronin) Buckley. He was educated in St. Patrick Grammar School and was the First Graduating Class of Central Catholic High School class of 1939. He worked for the City of Lawrence as a Tax Collector for over 30 years until his retirement in 1983. In 1935 he was named the "Most Typical Newspaper Boy" the boy with the Million Dollar Smile out of seven hundred contenders. He was a member of various clubs and organizations throughout the Greater Lawrence Area including: Life Member 4th Degree Knights of Columbus, Lawrence Council #67, Ancient Order Of Hibernians Division #8 and the Newburyport AOH Division One. He was the past Chairman of South Lawrence Associates Christmas Parades & St. Patrick Day Parades. He was Irishman of the year in 1974. He was the husband of the late Rita A.
