James Andrew Zahn, 47, passed away following a courageous battle with cancer on Saturday, October 29, 2011 at the Merrimack Valley Hospice House, surrounded by his loving family and closest friends. Born on August 21st, 1964, Jimmy was a lifelong resident of Lawrence. He was the son of Frances (Reusch) Zahn and Edward Bruce Zahn both of Lawrence. Jimmy graduated from Lawrence High School, Class of 1982, and continued his education at North Adams State College. In 1988 he proudly became a Lawrence Firefighter and in 2003 he was promoted to Lieutenant. A hard working man, he also was employed at Iron Mountain for over 20 years. Jimmy took a much deserved retirement in 2011.
