Mr. L. Francis "Frank" Sirois, 73, of Amesbury Massachusetts passed away on Saturday August 22, 2009 at the Merrimac Valley Hospital in Haverhill, MA. Born in Lawrence Massachusetts, Frank was the son of the Late Germaine (Schelling) and Ludger Sirois. Frank was a 1955 graduate of Central Catholic High School and held a degree in electrical engineering from Wentworth Institute of Technology.
