## **James McAndrew**

**J**ames McAndrew (72) lost his battle with cancer on Saturday, June 15, 2019 surrounded by family at High Point House in Haverhill, MA. He leaves behind his four children: sons James Jr, John and his wife Patricia, and Patrick and daughter Katherine (McAndrew) Benning and her husband Erich along with 8 grandchildren: James III, Andrew, Mary, Patrick, Jacob, Andrea, Ashley, and Alexander and one great-grandchild, Austin. He was predeceased by his parents John and Constance, and his brother John Jr and leaves his four sisters: Constance (Chippie) and her husband Fred, Jacqueline, Patricia, and Helen and her husband Frank along with many nieces and nephews.

James was a US Army veteran (1966-1968) and spent most of his life in Methuen. He was a long time member of The Elks and retired from serving as a Haverhill, MA public transportation bus driver since 1997 after the business he owed in Lawrence with his father, U & I Battery and Ignition, closed.

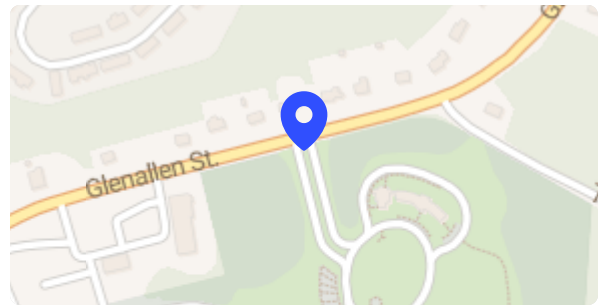
