MARILYN ANN KHOURY (1944-2022)

MARILYN PASSED AWAY PEACEFULLY AT HIGH POINTE HOSPICE FACILITY IN HAVERHILL FOLLOWING A COURAGEOUS BATTLE WITH TERMINAL CANCER. SHE WAS BORN IN LAWRENCE ON MARCH 3, 1944 TO THE LATE GEORGE J. AND “MILDRED” (DOMINICA MARUZZA) KHOURY.

SHE ATTENDED LAWRENCE SCHOOLS AND GRADUATED FROM SALEM STATE COLLEGE WITH BACHELOR AND MASTER’S DEGREES WITH HONORS.

MARILYN BEGAN HER ILLUSTRIOUS, ELEMENTARY TEACHING CAREER IN THE MARBLEHEAD SCHOOL SYSTEM FOR THREE YEARS FOLLOWED BY A TWO YEAR TENURE IN THE DANBURY, CT SCHOOL DISTRICT.

FOR THE NEXT, APPROXIMATE 30 YEARS, SHE TAUGHT AT THE WITCHCRAFT HEIGHTS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN SALEM, MA WHICH WOULD DEFINE HER CAREER. DURING THAT PERIOD, SHE WAS VOTED AS THE RUNNER-UP IN A POLL OF TOP ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THE NORTH SHORE.

MARILYN WAS ALSO A TALENTED SINGER AND GUITARIST WHO PERFORMED AT WEDDINGS. SHE MOST ENJOYED SINGING AND TUTORING THE CHILDREN IN HER EXTENDED FAMILY.

SHE HAD AN ACTIVE SOCIAL LIFE WITH HER MANY TEACHER FRIENDS AND COLLEAGUES IN SALEM, MA. SHE ALSO RELISHED SPENDING HOLIDAYS AND SPECIAL EVENTS WITH HER FAMILY MEMBERS.

SHE REALLY ENJOYED SITTING BY THE WATER IN SALEM, MA ON A SUMMER DAY AND ENJOYING A GOOD BOOK.
