James J. (Jim) Maloney of Methuen passed away peacefully on July 4th at Nevins Nursing & Rehab Center.

Jim was born on February 10, 1931 to the late James & Ruth (Abbott) Maloney and grew up in Lawrence. He attended St. Rita's & St. Mary's grammar schools and graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1948. He was part of the second graduating class of 1952 from Merrimack College. He enlisted in the Air Force after graduating from college and spent three years in Germany.

He and his wife & family moved to Methuen in 1964. He was appointed to the position of Town Clerk in Methuen in 1974, and when Methuen adopted its present form of government his title changed to City Clerk. He retired in 1997. After retirement he worked at Hickory Hill Golf Course & Campbells Scottish Highlands. He and his wife spent many winters in Florida and continued playing golf there. North Shore City & Town Clerks Assoc. Salem, Methuen Rotary Club, and Methuen Board of

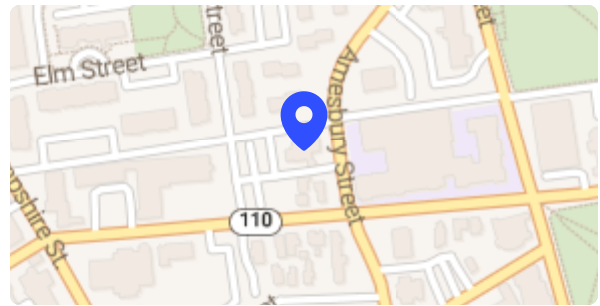

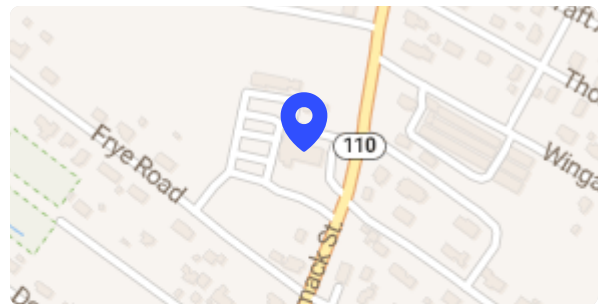

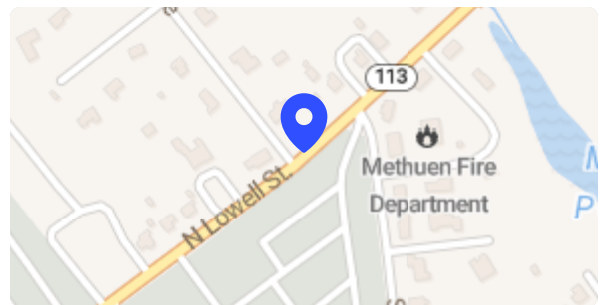
