Marilyn Rae (Squires) Becker (1938-2023)

Marilyn Rae Becker, 85, died peacefully on October 24, 2023. She was born in Oberlin, Ohio in 1938 to Marie and Robert Squires, Sr., and graduated from Amherst High School in Amherst, Ohio. She earned her RN in Nursing from the Providence School of Nursing in Sandusky, Ohio, and worked as a hospital nurse, private duty nurse, and then school nurse in Ohio.

Marilyn and her husband (John) Barry (1935-2009) raised their four children in Vermilion: Pamela, Scott, Rae Dene (Norton) and Jenifer. They were active in St Mary Parish and in the children's school activities.
